

Emma Jang, soprano



Vancouver-based soprano Emma Jang holds her M.Mus in Opera Performance, having just completed her degree at the University of British Columbia under the tutelage of director Nancy Hermiston. She last appeared with UBC Opera as Gretel in Humperdinck's *Hansel and Gretel* this past December. Past credits with UBC Opera include Second Wood Sprite (*Rusalka*), Barbarina (*Le nozze di Figaro*), Gianetta (*The Gondoliers*), Corinna (*Il viaggio a Reims*), and First Spirit and Papagena (*Die Zauberflöte*), in addition to performing in productions such as *Shadow Catch*, *Pasazzerka* and *Les contes d'Hoffmann*. Emma has also performed in collaboration with local companies such as Opera West, Bard on the Beach, Opera Unbound, and Players & Singers. She understudied the role of Dukdukdiya for Vancouver Opera's touring

production of *The Flight of the Hummingbird*, and was also a recipient of this year's Tony and Hildegard Cavelti Foundation Award, which was distributed as part of the Vancouver Opera Foundation Bursary Program.
